WOFCO's commitment is to supply products with the most responsible origin, in order to satisfy the needs of the most demanding markets.

Due to this reason, responsible sources and the fishery improvement projects are the premises of our work, because they allow to minimize the environmental impact and contribute to the sustainability of our activity. Industrial and commercial WOFCO's work would not be possible without the availability of seafood. The fact of guaranteeing the sustainability of these raw materials has been an essential priority, since our beginning. The health of oceans and the well-being of the communities, who depend on these fishing resources, are also in the centre of our daily work.

In WOFCO, we understand the supply chain of fishery products as a balanced system, where all parts count, from fishermen to the final consumer. All these parts have to be involved in the protection of environment, and as a consequence of their activity, these parts have to be satisfied. In this way, we are going to be able to guarantee the balance between ocean health and future seafood availability.

As a proof of our commitment, WOFCO has decided to adopt the [Target 75 Initiative of the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership \(SFP\)](#), as the cornerstone of our fishery sustainability policy. The assessment of a product as "Responsibly sourced", will be defined by the criteria used by the Target 75 initiative of SFP, and it will be universally enforceable.

To achieve this target, WOFCO commits to:

- 1- Promote and communicate actively raw materials, which achieve the definition of "Responsibly Sourced".
- 2- Prioritize raw materials which achieve the definition of "Responsibly Sourced".
- 3- Stimulate and encourage to our suppliers to offer only raw materials under the Target 75 initiative.
- 4- Promote the Target 75 initiative due to its integrated and multidisciplinary nature. Target 75 includes under its assessment, different certification schemes, fishery improvement projects and other reliable proof that state the degree of sustainability from different origins.
